

GMS Remote Learning Inclement Schedule

The Gilford School Board approved a plan for inclement weather days on November 6, 2023. It was decided that the first inclement weather day, which we have already had, will be a traditional snow day (no instruction). Our next inclement weather day, depending on when it falls, could be a traditional snow day or a remote learning day. We will avoid remote learning days the Friday before a vacation or the Monday after a vacation. We will avoid two remote learning days in a row. We will take into consideration the type of precipitation when considering a remote learning day. As an example, we will not have a remote learning day during an ice storm.

Teachers will have a scheduled Google Meet for direct instruction or activity every period, and will take attendance. Students are expected to attend and be present with faces shown for attendance and instructional components and expected to work during the entire block or will be marked absent. Staff are available for questions through email or Google Meet during office hours.

Student Google Meet Expectations

- Google Meet links can be found in the Google Classroom for each class.
- Be on time.
- Mute your microphone unless contributing or called on.
- Be mindful of air time.
- Dress school appropriate. The expectation is you will be visible and present.
- Any screenshots, photos, or any other recording of Google Meets are not allowed. Please be sure your phone is put away and not present during class time.
- Complete and turn in all assignments.
- Communicate with remote teachers, be an active participant within their virtual classes and seek additional assistance when needed.
- Teachers will be available during office hours to answer any questions students have via Google Meet or through email.
- If possible, find a space that is quiet and has little disruption. Let the people you live with know you are attending class. We are in a school environment, so you need to be awake and ready to work.
- Be patient with technology. Be honest about your network connection.
- Learners can choose to have an appropriate background if they choose not to show their home environment. The background should be appropriate and selected by the learner prior to the start of class so background changes don't cause a distraction during class.
- Noncompliance of these expectations could lead to the teacher removing the learner from the meeting which also will result in a behavior referral.

Student Attendance

- Attend all virtual class meetings and continue coursework for the entire remote scheduled block for each of their assigned courses each day. Attendance will be taken for each course. The school attendance policy will be in effect for remote students. Please see the GMS attendance policy in the student handbook.
